LIFE IN THE FASTER LANE

**Daniel Saylor and David Campos To Be Presenters
at the Michigan Defense Trial Counsel Winter Conference**

DETROIT – November 17, 2005 – The Michigan Defense Trial Counsel (MDTC) will be holding its winter conference, “Life in the Faster Lane: Avoid Pitfalls of the Fast Track at the Trial Court Level” on December 2, 2005 at the Troy Marriott. Daniel Saylor and David Campos, both attorneys and shareholders at Garan Lucow Miller, PC, will be presenters at the MDTC conference.

Mr. Saylor will discuss the recent landmark decisions of Kreiner, Devillers and Cameron in his presentation entitled “Favorable defense decisions – but if pushed too far, do we risk a legislative overreaction?” All three cases – two recently issued by the Michigan Supreme Court, and the other (Cameron) currently pending before the Court – are perceived as very “insurance friendly.” Mr. Saylor will refute the popular outcry against these favorable decisions.

Mr. Campos will talk about the *Griffith v. State Farm* Supreme Court decision in 2005 related to “allowable expenses” under the Michigan Automobile No-Fault Insurance Act, particularly as it pertains to catastrophic injury claims. As stated in his oral argument before the Supreme Court, Mr. Campos will offer suggestions for practitioners handling catastrophic injury cases in light of the holding in the Supreme Court’s decision in *Griffith*.
